Briefing

This publication provides an analysis of the results of the Agriculture Producer Price Index (APPI) for July 2018 with the base year 2016. In addition, the publication provides the results of calculating the contributions ratios of the Agriculture groups in the overall percentage change for the current month compared with the previous month.

Key Points

- Prices of the Agriculture Producer Price Index (APPI) increased by 22.3% during July 2018 compared with July 2017, where the APPI was 114.9 % in July 2018 compared with 94.0% in July 2017.
- Prices of the Agriculture Producer Price Index (APPI) increased by 29.3% during July 2018 compared with Jun 2018, where the APPI increased from 88.9% in June 2018 to 114.9% in July 2018.
- The "Tomato" group contributed 92.6% to the overall increase in the APPI in July 2018 compared with June 2018, where the prices of this group increased by 43.8% with a weight of 65.2%.
- The "Marrow" group contributed 8.1% to the overall increase in the APPI in July 2018 compared with June 2018, where the prices of this group increased by 27.6% with a weight of 5.6%.
- The "Corn" group contributed to the rate of increase during the month of July 2018 compared with June 2018 which was 1.0%, where the prices of this group increased by 14.6%.
- Despite the increase of the Agricultural Producers Price Index in July of 2018 compared to June 2018 caused by the prices' increase of "Tomato" and "Kusa" groups. But the prices of most of the groups have declined or stabilized prices, where "Potato" group prices decreased 12.6%, "Sweet Peppers" prices declined by 16.7%, "Cucumber" group decreased by 16.0% and "Onion" decreased by 15.7%.




